Wreath laying at the Tomb of the Unknown

Laying a wreath at the Tomb is an honor for The Chapter. We were fortunate this year but are not always successful in getting a slot in the busy schedule of the Tomb Guards. If you can, please make an effort to attend. The Chapter will designate two members to represent the 101st Association and perform the ceremony. The Honor Guard and our representatives will descend the marble steps from the amphitheater and place the wreath in front of the Tomb. The Guard Bugler will then sound Taps.



War Memorial Remembrance Wreaths

We will visit the Vietnam, Korean and WWII memorial on the morning of the 28th. We have a bus reserved for the ride from the hotel to the plaza. We will collect \$5 per person at the bus to defray the cost somewhat.

101st Memorial Wreath Laying Ceremony and Dinner

We will have a wreath laying at the 101st Memorial on Saturday the 28th at 3 p.m. The Memorial is directly across from the front of the Visitors Center. If you would like to sponsor a wreath for your loved one or a 101st chapter or unit, the wreath order form is included below. Afterwards, dinner will be served at the Sheraton Pentagon City at 5pm. Cost of the dinner \$43 per person.

Sunday May 29th

There are no organized events on Sunday but the hospitality suite will be open with beer, soft drinks an snacks. You are welcome to drop in and visit with other veterans. Typically, veterans of the 82nd Airborne also drop by. They have been very supportive of our group in past years.
